

## Pendant holding a large bead

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### Requirements:

Size 20 thread, 36 small beads (size 15 were used in the sample),  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch (15 mm) diameter round bead with a hanging ring or, if you can't find one with a hanging ring, use a round bead with a hole through the centre and make a hanging ring using a jewellery finding split or jump ring and a few small beads,

You will also need a necklace chain, and the usual tatting equipment.

### Abbreviations:

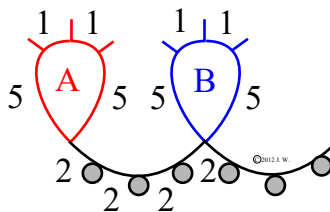
R. = ring, p = picot, cl = close ring, RW = reverse work, CH. = chain

B = bead

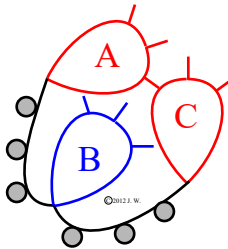
String the 36 small beads then wind about 2½ metres on your shuttle. Do not cut.

Leave the beads on the ball thread.

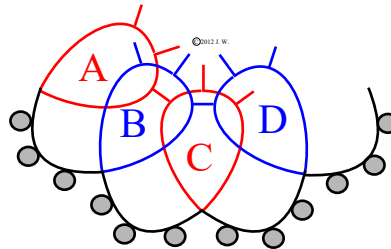
- R.A 5, p, 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW  
 R.B 5, p, 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW



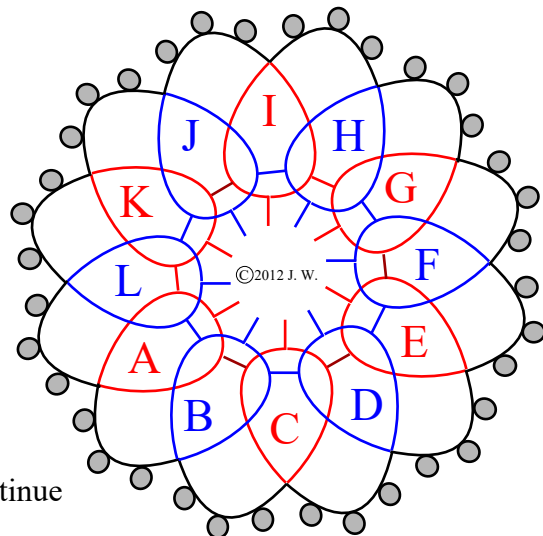
- R.C 5, + to ring 'A' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW



- R.D 5, + to ring 'B' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW



- R.E 5, + to ring 'C' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW  
 R.F 5, + to ring 'D' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW  
 R.G 5, + to ring 'E' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW  
 R.H 5, + to ring 'F' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW  
 R.I 5, + to ring 'E' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW  
 R.J 5, + to ring 'F' 1, p, 1, p, 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW



- R.K 5, + to ring 'I' 1, p, 1, + to ring 'A', 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension, RW

Slip the large bead between the two sets of rings then continue

- R.L 5, + to ring 'J' 1, p, 1, + to ring 'B', 5, cl, RW  
 CH 2, B, 2, B, 2, B, 2, tension,

Cut and tie to the base of ring 'A' then secure the ends

Thread the necklace through the loop on the centre bead.
