

## Angel with net wings

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Hair - small picots  
Hands - beads



Hair - double picots  
Hands - beads  
Skirt - mini dagger  
bead trim



Hair - graded double picots  
Hands - no beads  
Skirt - seed bead trim

### Requirements:

Size 20 thread, 6 size 9 or 11 beads (for the hands), 13 mini dagger beads, 13 size 11 seed beads, star sequin or charm a small piece of net 2 inch/5 cm square and the usual tatting equipment.

### Abbreviations:

R. = ring, dp = downward/dropped picot, p = picot (opened paper clip picot gauge), Lp = double picot - (lollypop stick picot gauge), + = join, B = bead, cl = close ring, RW = reverse work, CH. = chain,

'dp' = work 3 second half stitch, leave a space for the picot, then work 3 first half stitches

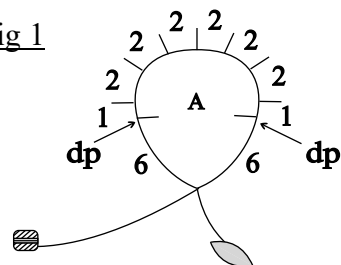
### The Angel - follow the options for adding beads

- 1) For the beaded trim on the skirt string either 13 mini dagger or 13 seed beads, then
- 2) for the bead hands string 6 flesh coloured beads, then
- 3) wind about 2½ metres on your shuttle, with the 'hand' beads if working this option, leave the other beads on the ball thread. Do not cut.

#### Head with small picot 'hair'

R.A 6, dp (see abbreviations), 1, (p, 2) x 6, p, 1, dp, 6,  
coax the dps to face downwards, then cl, (Fig 1)

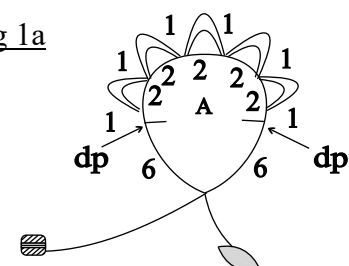

#### Head with double picot 'hair'

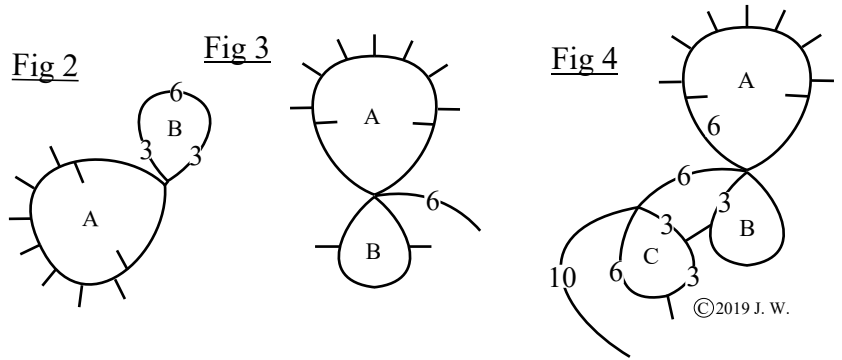
R.A 6, dp (see abbreviations) 1, (Lp,2, + to Lp, 1) x 5,  
dp, 6, coax the dps to face downwards, then cl, (Fig 1a)

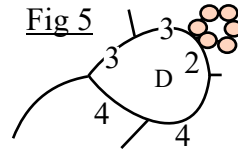
All versions

- R.B 3, p, 6, p, 3, cl (Fig 2),  
reverse ring 'B' (Fig 3)
- CH. 6, RW

- R.C 3, + to ring 'B', 3, p, 6, cl, RW
- CH. 10, RW



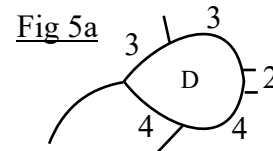
Option with beaded hands

- R.D Bring the 6 beads into the ring round your hand:  
3, + to ring 'C', 3, move up the 6 beads and make  
the long picot (the size of the 6 beads plus a space  
for another bead). 2, p, 4, p, 4, cl, (Fig 5), RW



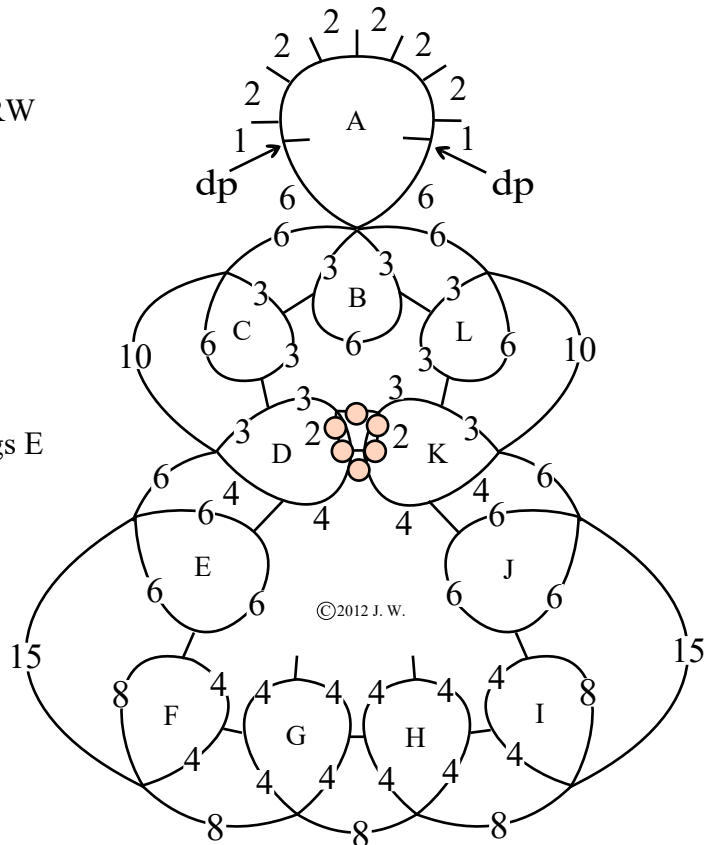
Option of no beads for hands

- R.D 3, + to ring C, 3, p, 2, p, 4, p, 4, cl, (Fig 5a), RW



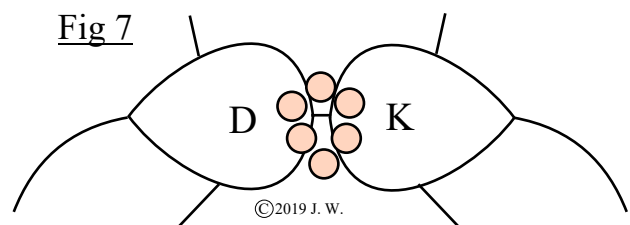
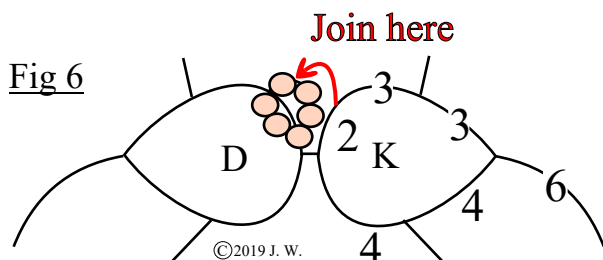
Skirt without beads

- CH. 6, RW
- R.E 6, + to the last picot on ring D, 6, p, 6, cl, RW
- CH. 15, RW
- R.F 8 + to free picot on ring E, 4, p, 4, cl, RW
- CH. 8, RW
- R.G 4, + to ring F, 4, p, 4, p, 4, cl, RW
- CH. 8, RW
- R.H 4, + to ring G, 4, p, 4, p, 4, cl, RW
- CH. 8, RW
- R.I 4, + to ring H, 4, p, 8, cl, RW
- CH. 15, tension to match the chain between rings E  
and F, RW
- R.J 6, + to ring I, 6, p, 6, cl, RW
- CH. 6, RW



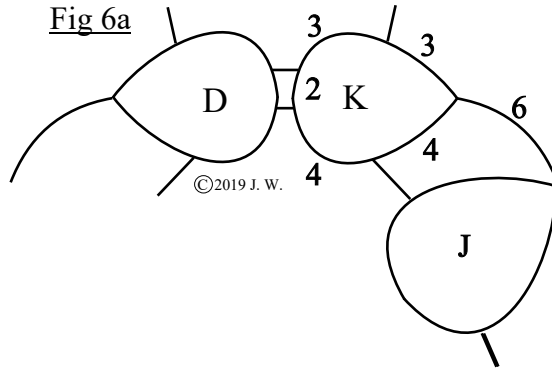
Hands with beads

- R.K 4, + to the free picot on ring J, 4, + to  
ring D, 2, + to the beaded long picot with  
5 beads on the left of the join and 1 bead on  
the right ( Fig 6 below) 3, p, 3, cl, the beads  
will sit on top of the previous join (Fig 7)



Joining the non beaded hands

R.K 4, + to ring J, 4, + to ring D, 2,  
+ to ring D, 3, p, 3 cl, RW

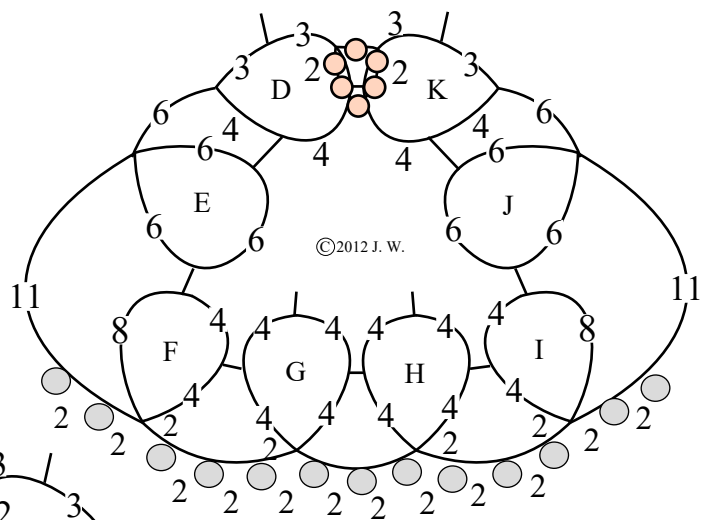


Beaded skirt version

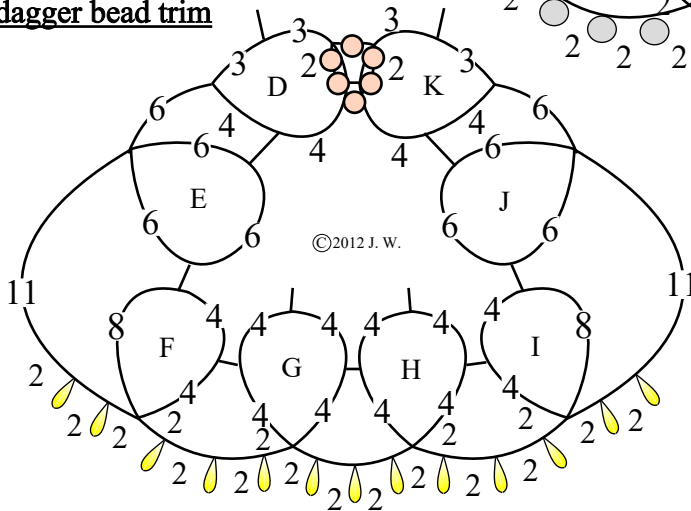
Work ring D then continue

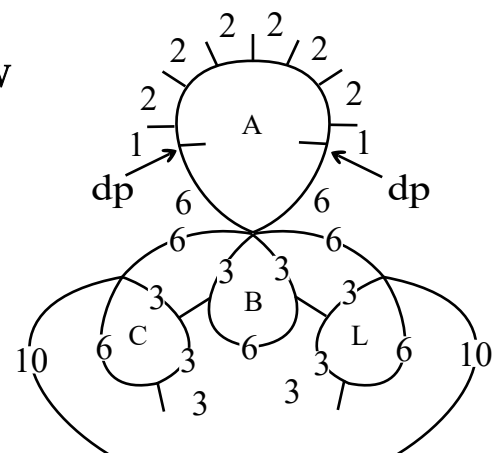
Skirt with mini dagger bead trim

CH. 10, tension to match the chain between rings C and D, RW  
 R.L 6, + to ring K, 3, + to ring B, 3, cl, RW  
 CH. 6.

Cut and tie between rings A and B and secure the ends  
 Block and stiffen as required.



## Wings

Take the square of net (Fig 7) and fold it diagonally (Fig 8).

Thread a needle with about 12 inches/30 cm of white tatting cotton or sewing thread and make a line of running stitches down the centre of the triangle of net as in Fig 9.

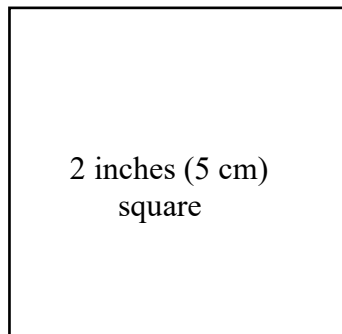

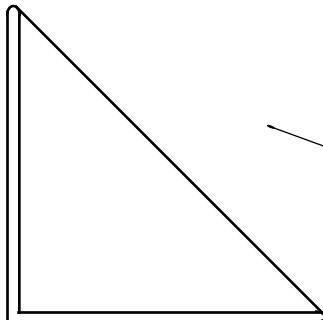
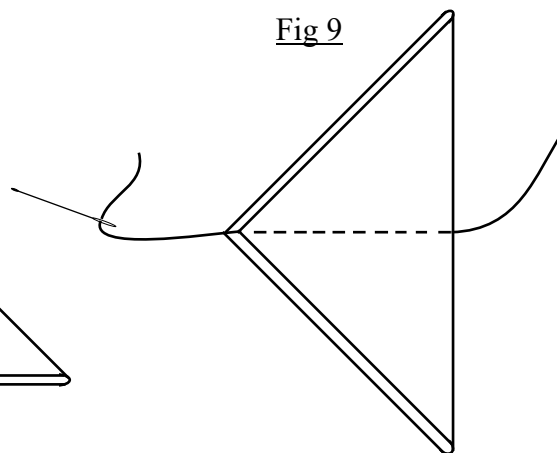

Pull up the thread to gather the stitches then tie the ends to hold the gathers in place.

Attach the wings behind ring B with the folded edge uppermost.

Tie the sequin star, or charm, in place.
