Size 20 thread, $\frac{5}{8}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ inch (15 - 19 mm) cabochon, 2 picot gauges (opened out paper clip and a cocktail stick, and the usual tatting equipment.

R. = Ring, p = picot, mp = medium sized picot, cl, close ring,RW = reverse work, CH. = Chain, + = join



- R.N 6, + to the same picot as ring M, 6, cl, RW
- CH 9, tension as in the photo,
- *CH. 9, tension as in the photo, RW
- R.O 6, + to the picot on the adjacent chain on row 1, 6, cl, RW
- CH. 7, p, 1, mp, 1, p, 7, tension as in the photo, RW
- R.P 6, + to the same picot as previous ring, RW
- CH. 9, tension as in the photo.**

Repeat from * to ** four more times to complete the row.

Cut and tie then secure the ends.

Block and stiffen as required.
