

Ice Drop Mary

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Requirements:

Size 20 thread, 5/8 - 3/4 inch (15 - 19 mm) cabochon,
2 picot gauges (opened out paper clip and a cocktail stick,
and the usual tatting equipment.

Abbreviations:

R. = Ring, p = picot, mp = medium sized picot, cl, close ring,
RW = reverse work, CH. = Chain, + = join



Row 1

Wind about 6 meters on your shuttle. Do not cut.

- R.A, 5, p, 4, p, 5, cl, Fig 1), RW
 R.B, 4, p, 4, p, 4, p, 4, cl (Fig 2)
 Fold ring B down behind ring A
 CH. 6, p, 6, tension to 5/8 inch (15 mm) (Fig 3), RW
 R.C 5, + to ring A, 4, p, 5, cl, RW
 R.D 4, + to ring B, 4, p, 4, p, 4, cl
 Fold down ring D behind ring C
 CH. 6, p, 6, tension to 5/8 inch (15 mm), RW
 R.E 5, + to ring C, 4, p, 5, cl, RW
 R.F 4, + to ring D, 4, p, 4, p, 4, cl
 Fold ring F down behind ring E
 CH. 6, p, 6, tension to 5/8 inch (15 mm), RW
 R.G 5, + to ring E, 4, p, 5, cl, RW
 R.H 4, + to ring F, 4, p, 4, p, 4, cl
 Fold ring H down behind ring G
 CH. 6, p, 6, tension to 5/8 inch (15 mm), RW
 R.I 5, + to ring G, 4, p, 5, cl, RW
 R.J 4, + to ring H, 4, p, 4, p, 4, cl
 Fold ring J down behind ring I
 CH. 6, p, 6, tension to 5/8 inch (15 mm), RW
 R.K 5, + to ring I, 4, + to ring A, 5, RW
 R.L Slip the cabochon between the two sets of rings
 4, + to ring J, 4, p, 4, + to ring B, 4, cl
 CH. 6, p, 6, tension to 5/8 inch (15 mm),
 sj to base of rings A and B.
 Continue to row 2

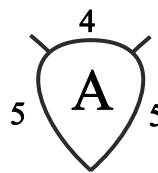

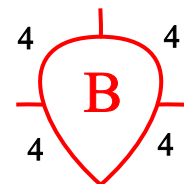

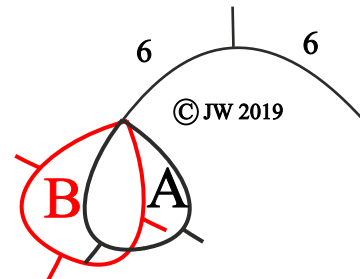
