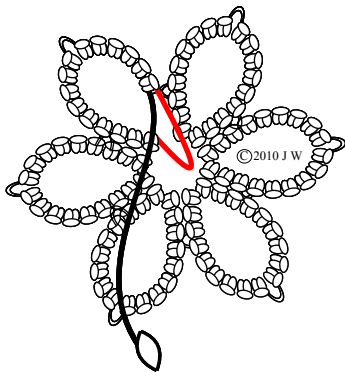


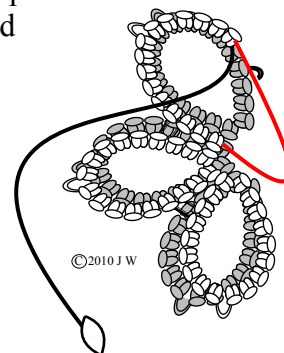
How to join the last ring to the first ring - a 'folded' join

The rings in this sample are: 3 - (or +) 6 - 6 - (+ on the 6th ring) 3

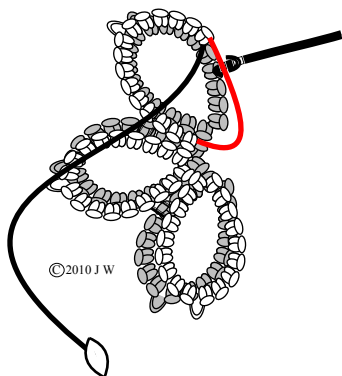
1/ Work the final ring as far as the join



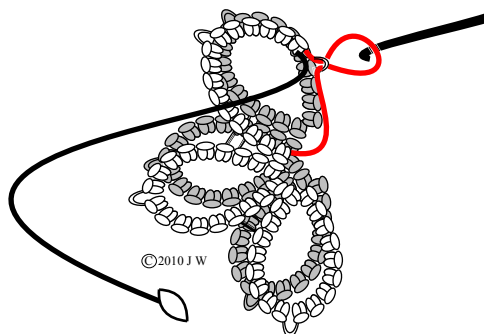
2/ Fold the motif away from you, bring the first ring in place behind your work and match it up with the final ring



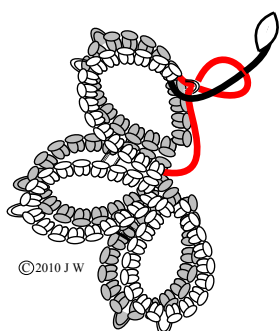
3/ insert a crochet hook through the picot that you wish to join to from the back



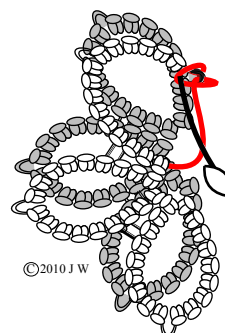
4/ hook the working thread (the one round your hand NOT the shuttle thread) and draw a loop through the joining picot



5/ now pass your shuttle through the loop from front to back
NB make sure that the loop hasn't twisted



6/ adjust the threads, as for a normal join, then work a second half stitch



7/ complete the ring according to the pattern
