

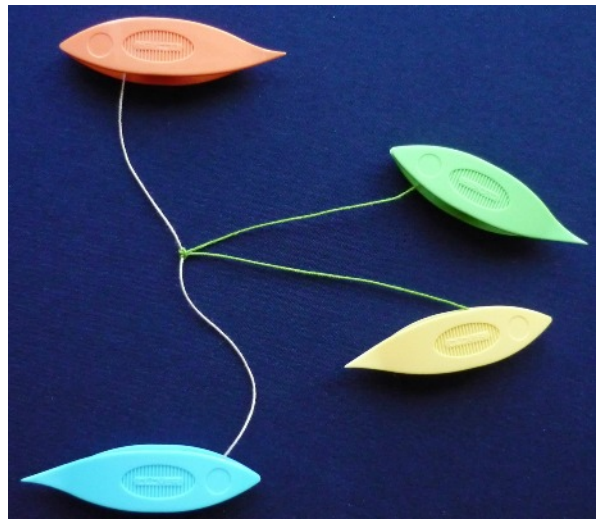
Split Ring Braid - method 2

Wind 2 pairs of shuttles, each pair to be wound CTM.

1)

For this sample the threads are joined together.

The stitch count for the split rings is 8/8.



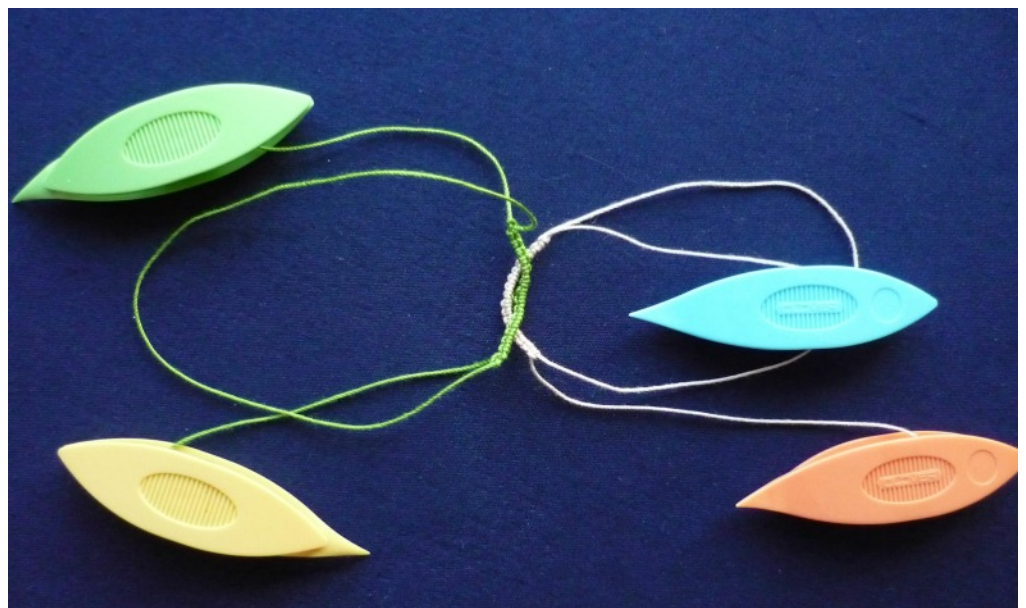
2)

Using shuttles G (green) and Y (yellow) work a SR but do not close it.

Using shuttles B (blue) and O (orange) work a SR but do not close it.

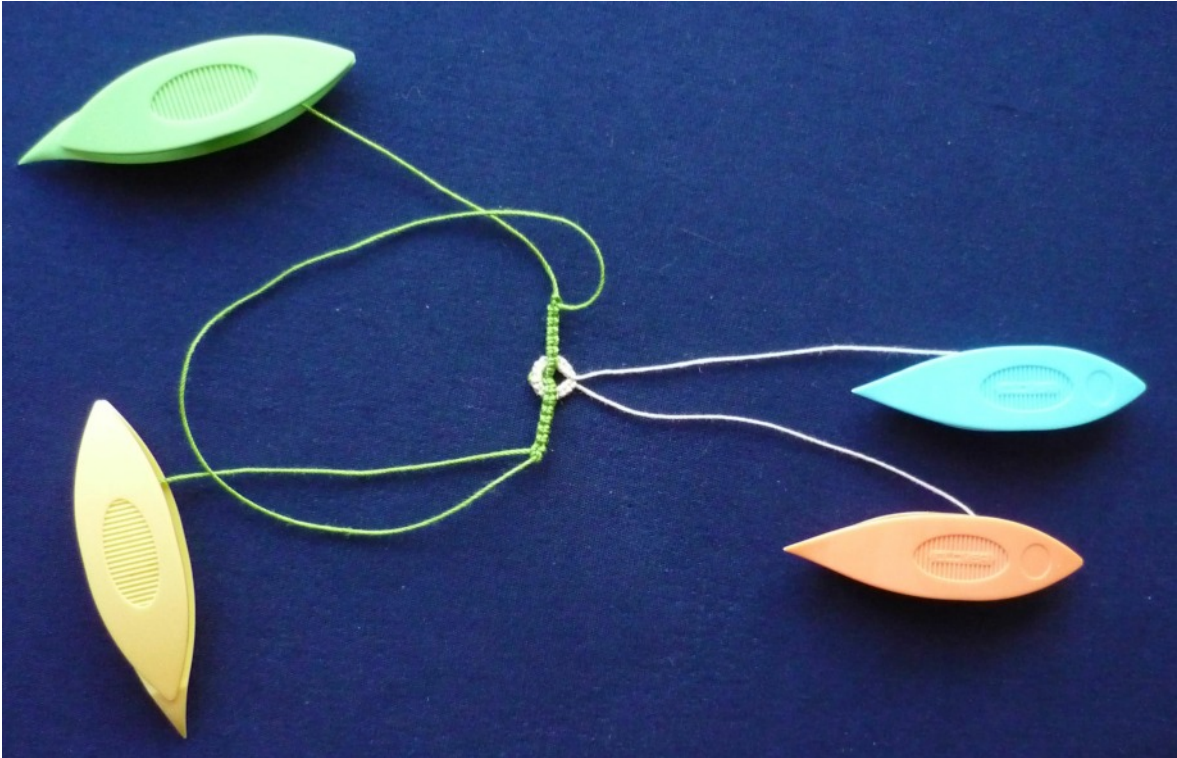


3) Pass the SR worked with shuttles G and Y through the SR made with shuttles B and O from the back to the front.



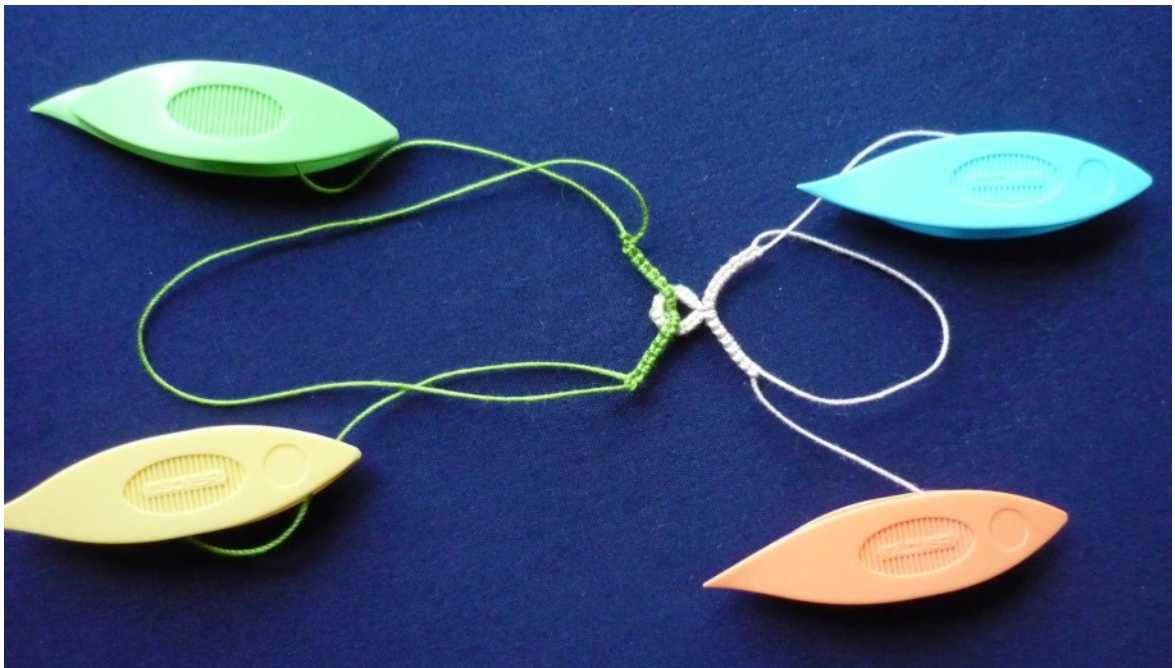
4)

Close the SR made with shuttles B and O.

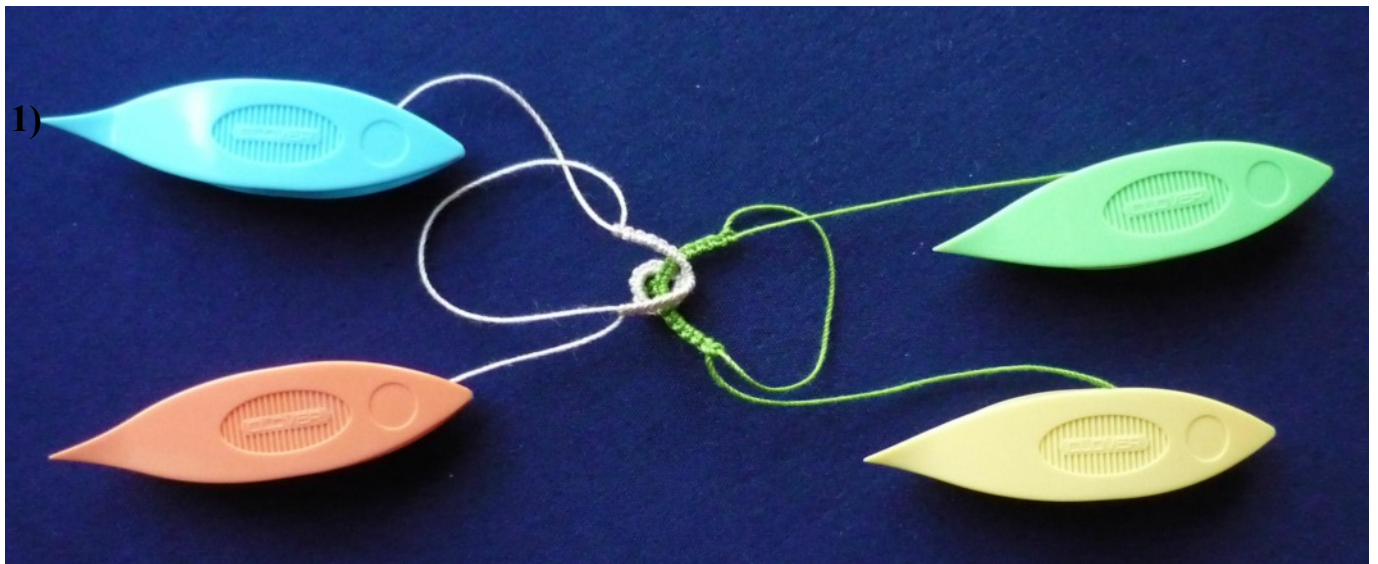


5)

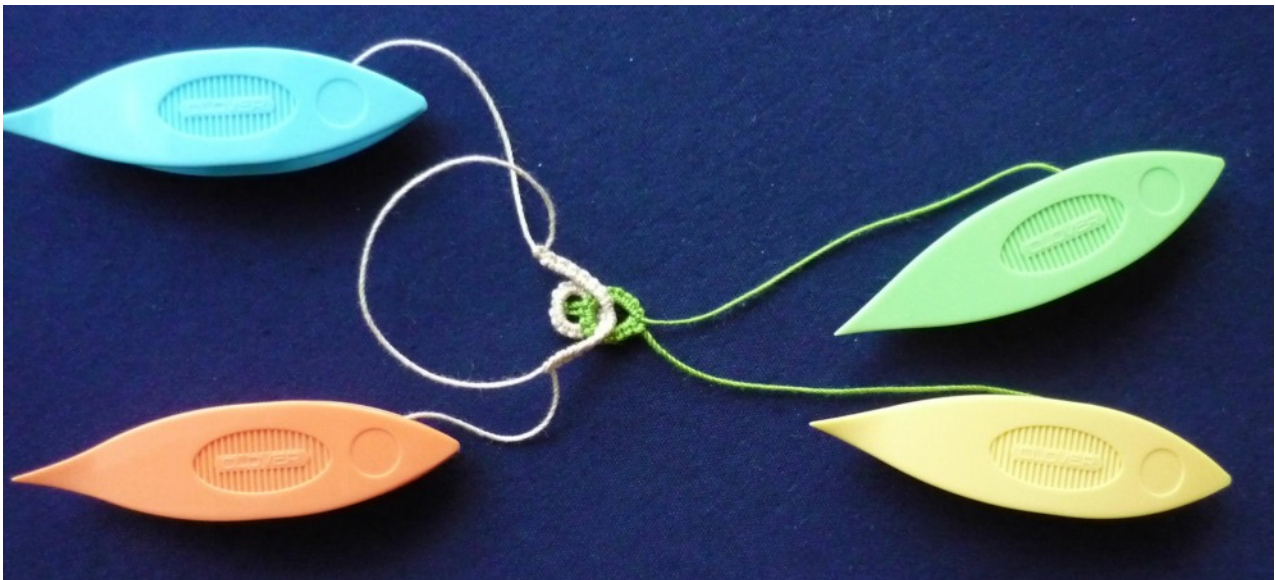
Using shuttles B and O work another SR but do not close it.



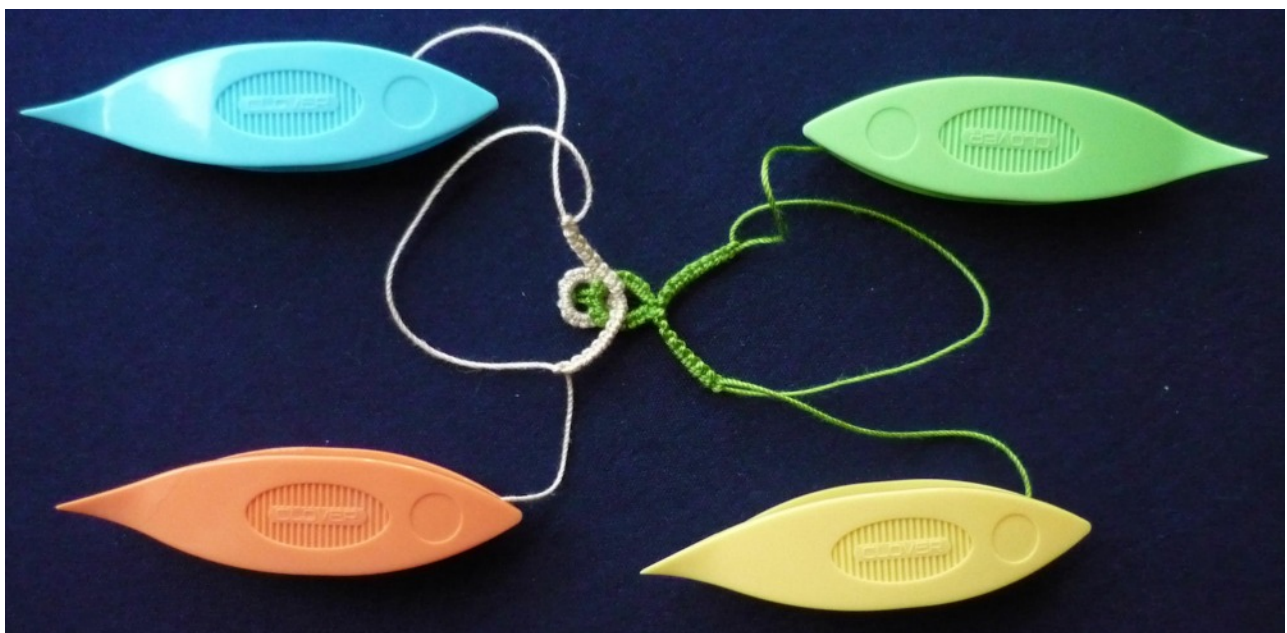
6) Pass the SR made with shuttles B and O up through the previous SR made with shuttles G and Y.



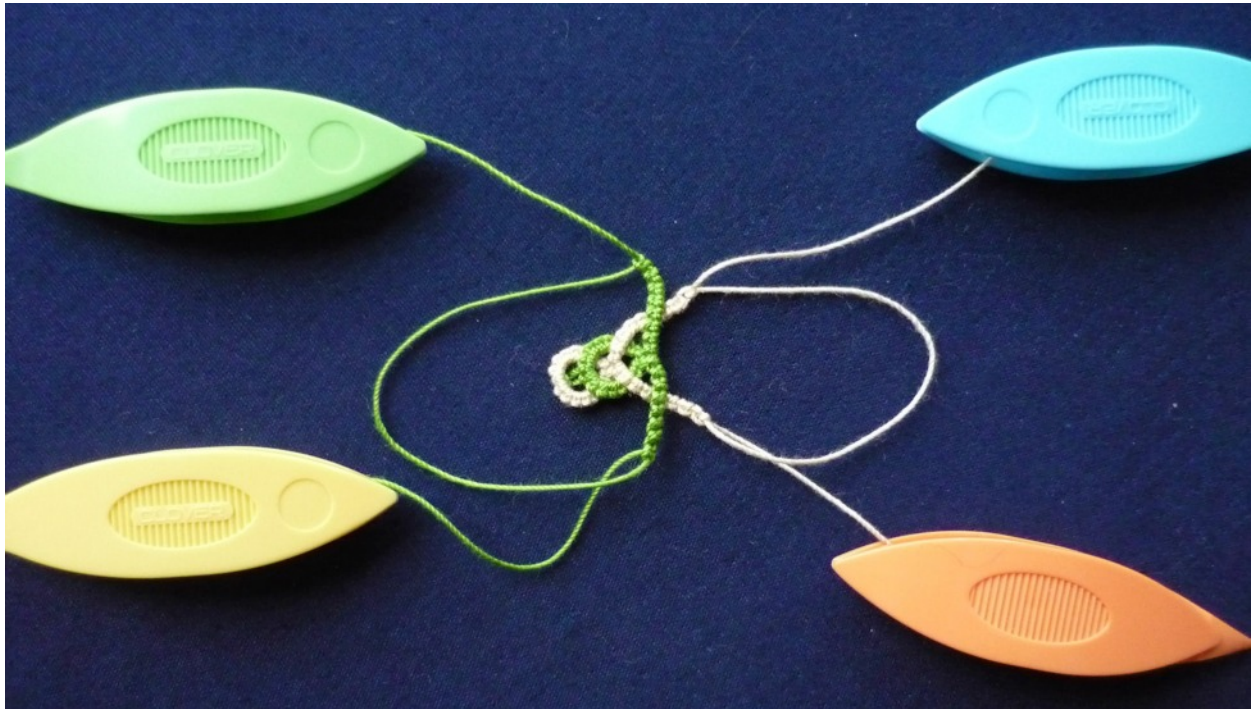
7) Close the SR made using shuttles G and Y.



8) Work another SR using shuttles G and Y but do not close it.



9) Pass the SR made using shuttles G and Y up through the previous SR made using shuttles B and O.



10) Close the SR made using shuttles B and O. Repeat from 5) for the length required.
