

## Flower with Josephine rings

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### Requirements:

size 20 thread and the usual tatting equipment

### Abbreviations:

R. = ring p = picot cl = close ring RW = reverse work

CH. = chain += join JR = Josephine ring



### Row 1

Wind about 1 ½ metres on your shuttle.

Do not cut.

R.A 4, p, 4, large picot, 4, p, 4, cl, RW

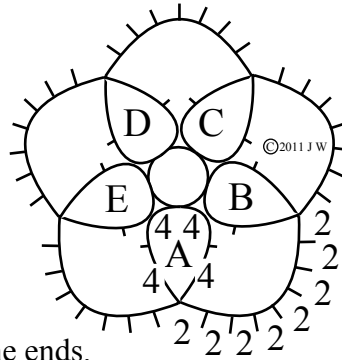
CH. 2, (p, 2) x 7, RW

\*R.B 4, p, 4, += to large picot on ring 'A', 4, p, 4, cl, RW

CH. 2, (p, 2) x 7, RW

Repeat from \* three times more.

Cut and tie to the base of ring 'A' then secure the ends.



### Row 2

The rings in this row are joined to the 1<sup>st</sup> row underneath the chains of the 1<sup>st</sup> row as in the picture at the top of the page.

Wind about 2 metres on your shuttle. Do not cut.

R.F 7, += to the picot on the right hand side of ring 'E', 1, += to the picot on the left hand side of ring 'A', 7, cl, RW

CH. 2, (p, 2) x 5, RW

JR.G 1 double stitch then 16 second half stitches, cl, RW

CH. 2, (p, 2) x 5, RW

\*R.H 7, += to the right hand picot of the same ring of the 1<sup>st</sup> row, 1, += to the left hand picot on the next ring on the 1<sup>st</sup> row, 7, cl, RW

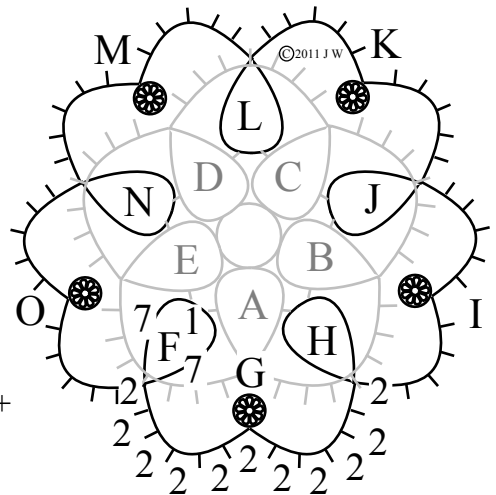
CH. 2, (p, 2) x 5, RW

JR.I 1 double stitch then 16 second half stitches, cl, RW

CH. 2, (p, 2) x 5, RW

Repeat from \* three times more then cut and tie to the base of ring 'F'.

Secure ends.



In the diagram opposite the rings and chains of row 1 are in red and row 2 is shown in black.
